Treasurer's Report / Financial Statement | Adrian Stagg

- Tabled at meeting
- Club well situated to pay off debts and with changes to venue hire build up assets and value.
- New State funding round application (Club Development) proposals posited
 - o if QKR willing to act as sponsor:
 - \$5000 for large mat purchase (est. 64 sq.m or min. 40 mats per discipline) to enable two disciplines to train together; or buy 10 sets of Club bogu, shinai and bokken (for hiring out)
 - \$50000 to stimulate Qld Kendo with 10 similar kits suitable for 10 clubs to hire/borrow

Amendment to the BBRD USQ Martial Arts Club Constitution: Tabled at meeting:

- 10.4 In addition to the Executive Committee, a Technical Committee shall be formed. This will be comprised of the discipline head for each activity offered through the Club or their nominee and a nominated Occupational Health and Safety Officer.
 - 10.4.1 Members of the Technical Committee must be members of the Club, and can also be members of the Executive Committee.
 - 10.4.2 The Technical Committee can place non-binding recommendations to the Executive Committee regarding matters that affect the provision of activities. These recommendations are to be sanctioned via ordinary processes in order to be subsequently actioned by the Executive Committee.
 - 10.4.3 Membership of the Technical Committee is automatically terminated if an individual's Club membership is revoked or if it lapses.
